



GUIDELINES FOR POSTER PRESENTATION

Due to the virtual nature of the conference, we are only accepting Electronic Posters (E-Posters) in PDF format. Printed posters or photographs of printed posters will **NOT** be accepted.

Poster Submission Deadline: 15 March 2021.

The poster should be a clear visual presentation of your submitted abstract and should meet the following criteria:

Title of the Poster

- Please keep the title of the poster the same as in your submitted abstract.

Poster size and format

- Poster must be submitted in **PDF format**.
- Posters should be created in PowerPoint and must be sized at “on-screen show 16:9” with **Width: 25.4cm, Height 14.29cm** and then save it as a PDF.

Poster design

- **Please use the poster template provided.**
- The top of the Poster should display the following information: Title of your Paper, Name(s) of the Author(s) and Affiliation(s).
- For the author’s list, please underline the name of Presenter.
- Please put your ABSTRACT ID (e.g.: P2.36) and picture of presenter at the top right corner of the poster.
- You may **NOT** change the size of the poster as provided in the PowerPoint template; however, the arrangement of content within the poster can be according to your own preference.
- The content of the poster should be understandable without the need for an oral explanation.

Lettering

- Kindly use both UPPER and lower case letters for general content. It is recommended to use Sans Serif font style for the content of the poster.
- Text and presentation should be in **ENGLISH** only.
- Please note that this conference commends the use of person-first-language.

Content

- Each poster must include the following information: Title of paper, name of author(s), affiliation, introduction, methodology, results and discussion, conclusions, and references.
- Be selective when showing results. Present only results that illustrate the main findings of the project.

Illustrations

- Use only **static images** and **do not embed any videos or animation** in your poster.
- Use colours sparingly. Colours should be used only to emphasize, differentiate and to add interest.
- Results presented in a graph format are effective. Avoid large tables of data.
